Navigate to the network settings page (1-3) and make sure that eth0 is selected as the network interface (4).

Step 5 – Adjust the network settings



Choose between configuration via DHCP (dhcp) or static configuration (static) in the list Network type. For static configuration, enter IP address and Subnet mask and, if necessary, Network gateway, Nameserver 1, Nameserver 2, etc.

Make sure that the checkbox "Automatically start the network interface" is ticked. Then click on the button "Accept" and restart the control.

Attention! The IP-address range 192.168.100.* with the subnet mask 255.255.255.0 is used for the internal network of the machine. To avoid conflicts do not use this address range for the network interface *eth0*.
